

Charolais YMA Competition 2019

Charolais Skills Workshops:

- Cootehill Mart 2nd of March 2019
- Elphin Mart 27th of April 2019
- Thurles Mart 11th of May 2019

Includes:

- Grooming Demonstration with a talk given by the groomer and questions can be asked by young members.
- Showmanship demonstration what to wear, how to walk with an animal, how to present the animal, ring etiquette, etc.
- Talk given from an experienced judge and show young members what to look for in an animal.
- A stock judging competition will then be held with 4-5 animals present and then a guess the weight competition with points being allocated for correct placings, reasoning for placings and weight estimation.
- Talks provided by an AI companies and nutritionists.

Young Stock Person Classes at Local Agricultural Shows:

- The young people will be allocated points on participation in classes and placings.
- The shows where these classes will be held are yet to be confirmed.

Overall Final in Tullamore Show 11th of August 2019:

- First part of the day is the grooming section, participants will be judged on how well they participate in grooming their animal in preparation for the show.
- The animal used for this competition does not have to be owned by the young person, however they must be a Pedigree registered Charolais animal.
- Second part of the competition will be their young stockperson competition and points will be allocated by their placings.
- Finally, the participants will be asked questions about the breed and questions about judging their animal. Senior participants will be asked 5 questions and junior participants will be asked three questions.

Guess the weight	Individual animal weight - 5 points for correct weight (+/- 10 kg), deduct 1 point for every 10Kg incorrect. In the case of estimating 4 animal's weights and placings, it will be 1 point allocated for each correct weight within the range of (+/- 20kg) and an additional 1 point for guessing all weights correctly.	10

Overall Prizes:

Overall Winner of the Senior Section: A €1500 voucher towards the price of a pedigree registered Charolais heifer, purchased at either the official Irish Charolais Society Elite Heifer sale or the Irish Charolais Premier sale valid for the next three years. Along with a rosette and plaque.

Overall Winner of the Junior Section: A total of €750 consisted of vouchers for show supplies, and other selected Agri- businesses. Along with a rosette and plaque.

There will also be prizes for the runners up in the competition.
