

## **Charolais International YDP Application Form**

Two young Irish Charolais enthusiasts will once again be in with a chance of winning a trip to Canada in 2019. They will get the opportunity to travel to the Charolais International Conference in Canada and represent Ireland on the World Stage. YDP members from Charolais Societies all over the World will be joining them. As well as getting the opportunity to learn all the Stockmanship and Showmanship skills from the best in the business, they will get to visit some of the most beautiful parts of Canada. Travel, transport and accommodation costs will be covered by the Irish Charolais Cattle Society and Charolais International. The trip will run from the 22<sup>nd</sup> of July to the 31<sup>st</sup> of July. All participants must be aged between 18 – 22 years on the 22<sup>nd</sup> of July 2019. July 25<sup>th</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup> - CCYA Conference & Show

July 28<sup>th</sup> - Tour of Beck Farms, Elder Charolais and take in a tourist stop: St. Victor Petroglyphs

July 29<sup>th</sup> - Tour Rosso Charolais, Howe Family Farm and visit the Tunnels of Moose Jaw - The Chicago Connection story with Al Capone. Stay and swim at the Temple Gardens Mineral Spa that evening

July 30<sup>th</sup> - Tour Horseshoe E Charolais, Palmer Charolais and Buffalo Plains Feedlot

July 31<sup>st</sup> - Depart from Regina (YQR)

In order to select the two Irish participants, the Irish Charolais Cattle Society will hold a stock judging and knowledge of Charolais competition in Tullamore Mart on Saturday the 25<sup>th</sup> May 2019 following the Bull Sale, at approximately 3.30 pm. The winners will then be announced on Monday the 27<sup>th</sup> May 2019.
