Checklist for Members

The person applying for Membership of the Society must have their own herd number.

Please complete and return the Membership Application Form, the CMMS form and the Direct Debit mandate.

To become a member of the Society you must have at least one pedigree female officially transferred by the office into your name. If your name is printed as the owner on the pedigree certificate, then the animal is already in your name, if not, a transfer fee of \notin 25 applies for each female. Alternatively you must have bred one embryo calf.

All pedigree calves have to be notified to Breed Societies via the ICBF Animal Events Book or online through www.agfood.ie. Do not send any fees with your Animal Events Sheet. For members on direct debit, we will invoice you for the registration fees and certificates will be issued automatically. For all other members, we will invoice you for the registration fees and upon payment the certificate will be issued.

All stock bulls must have a DNA or Geno profile on record before calves can be registered. Please note, that all stock bulls born on/after 1st April 2024 must have a geno profile and be fully parentage verified.

<u>Please return all Pedigree Charolais Certificates with your Membership application forms. All</u> <u>pedigree females MUST be officially transferred into your name by the office to register calves out</u> <u>of them.</u>

Schedule of fees for Members

New Entrance Membership Fees, includes:

€75 New Membership entrance fee / €1 Share Fee / €1 Herd Prefix / €50 Annual Membership Fee. Life Membership fee €635. Annual membership fee each year is €50.

Registration fee per calf:

€60 if paying by Cash/Cheque
€45 if paying by direct debit
€80 for an E.T. calf registration (Embryo Transplant)
