There was a real flying trade for the 61 Charolais cattle sold by Messrs. J. P. and M. Doyle in Maynooth yesterday.

Top price of the day's sales was the 4,600 gns. paid by Lord Iveagh, for a heifer owned by the Department of Agriculture, while Lord Iveagh got a similar price for a cow with a heifer calf at foot, from Mr. Jim Hayes, of Saggart.

The highest price for a bull was 3,100 gns. paid by the Hibernian herd for Capt. Tim Rogers's bull. In all, five in-calf heifers made over 4,000 gns. each, and the sales total for the 61 cattle sold was 118,000 gns.
