PRIZE MONEY: 1st - €100; 2nd - €75; 3rd - €50

Entry fee per animal/entry - €15 (3 entries or more, fee capped at €45)

Class 1: Pedigree bull born on or between the 1st June 2024 to 31st August 2024

Class 2: Pedigree bull born on or between the 1st September 2024 to 31st October 2024

Class 3: Pedigree bull born on or between the 1st November 2024 to 31st December 2024

Class 4: Pedigree bull born on or after the 1st January 2025

Class 5: Pedigree heifer born on or between the 1st June 2024 to 31st August 2024

Class 6: Pedigree heifer born on or between the 1st September 2024 to 31st October 2024

Class 7: Pedigree heifer born on or between the 1st November 2024 to 31st December 2024

Class 8: Pedigree heifer born on or after the 1st January 2025

Class 9: Best pair of pedigree Charolais calves

Overall North Eastern Pedigree Charolais Calf Champion (confined to 1st and 2nd prize winners) – Winner will receive sash and prize worth €150

Reserve North Eastern Pedigree Charolais Calf Champion – Winner will receive prize worth €85

Class 10: Commercial Charolais sired bull calf born on or after the 1st of January 2025

Class 11: Commercial Charolais sired heifer calf born on or after the 1st of January 2025

Based on the number of entries, classes may be amalgamated on the day of the show.

Rules and Regulations for North Eastern Calf Show

- Every exhibitor in the pedigree classes must be a paid-up member of the North Eastern Charolais Club on the day of the show – membership fee is €20
- **Cheque payments for entry fees can be made payable to the 'North Eastern Charolais Club'**
- Every exhibitor must accept that the judge's decision is final
- All pedigree entries must be fully registered in the Irish Charolais Herd Book. All calves must be Irish bred. All purchased pedigree cattle must be transferred, through the Irish Charolais Cattle Society office, into the exhibitor's herd
- All commercial calves must crossbred but sired by a Charolais bull and have Charolais stated on its blue card. Stewards have the right to check this on the day of the show.
- All cattle exhibits must be on the show grounds by 11.00am on the morning of the show.
- All animals entered must be halter trained
- Exhibitors may need to bring their own bedding for pens on the day.
- **Judging will commence at 12.00 pm unless otherwise stated**
- **Each breeder must bring the blue card for all animals being shown on the day**
- All entries must be in test (TB and BVD) on the day of the show. All necessary documentation must accompany the animal on the day of the show.
- The committee reserves the right to postpone or cancel the show if necessary
- Classes may be cancelled or amalgamated due to insufficient entries.
- The committee delegates full power to the appointed Stewards, to enforce the Rules as set out, and the decision of the committee shall be final in all cases.
- The North Eastern Charolais Club, Ballyjamesduff Mart and the Irish Charolais Cattle Society will not be responsible for any loss, damage, accident or otherwise which may occur to any Exhibitor, Exhibit, Visitor or Vehicle at the Show
- The Judge shall not award a prize in any class where sufficient merit does not appear
- Please do not exhibit animals that are unsuitable with regard to safety e.g. hard to control.
- All animals must be led by a competent handler and the handler must be wearing either a white show coat or shirt in the show ring.
- **All exhibitors must have their own public liability insurance policy in the case of an accident occurring**
- The North Eastern Charolais Club advise all owners who have their animals insured, to have the insurance cover extended to cover them while showing animals at shows
- By entering an animal in the show, breeders accept that the Irish Charolais Cattle Society is entitled to take a hair sample for DNA/Genotyping analysis from any animal at the show and also agree to accept and abide by all decisions, rules and regulations regarding the show
